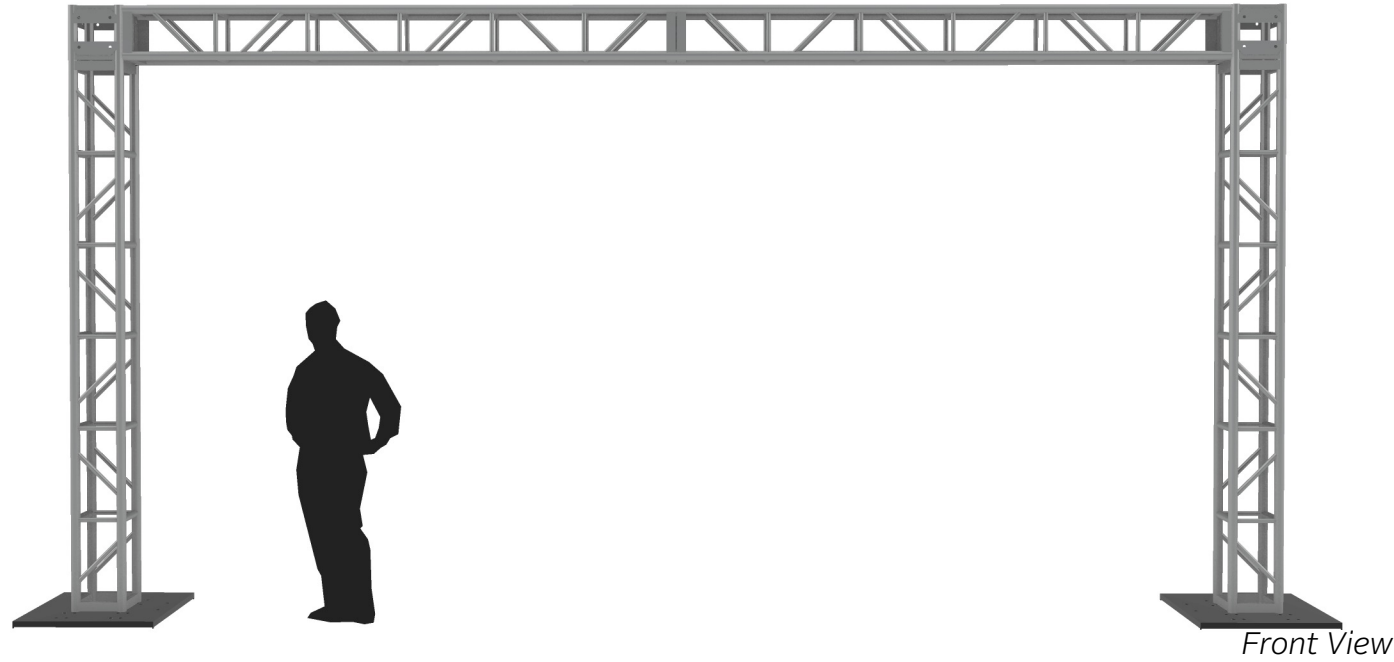

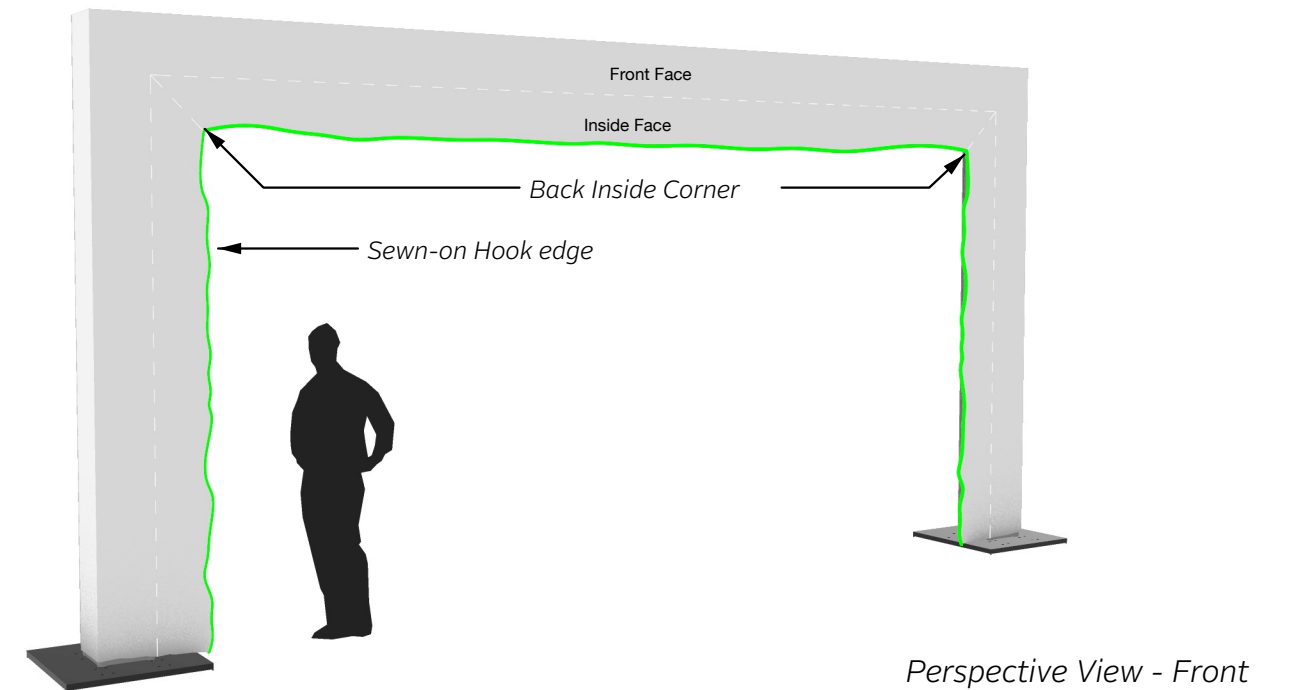

Assemble your desired truss structure to design spec and proper truss safety standards. Ballasting pictured below is representational only.



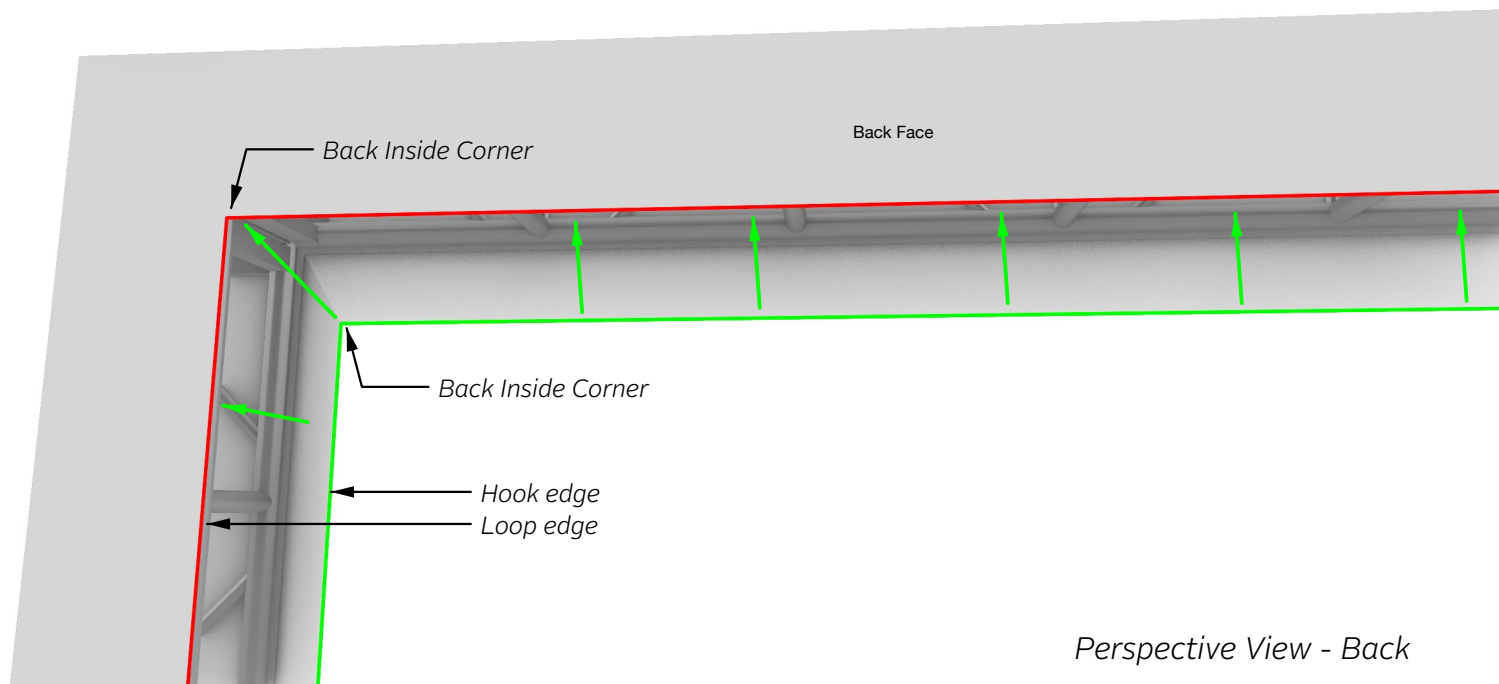

Loosely drape the fabric of your one piece truss banner over your constructed truss.

Attach the sewn-on hook edge to the sewn-on loop edge. Most common fabric truss banners will be configured to have the edges join on the BACK INSIDE edge. For even installation, close your hook & loop starting in the corners, and bisecting the open runs a few feet at a time until fully installed.

Adjust the fabric and hook/loop edges to fit, and smooth out and fabric wrinkles.
