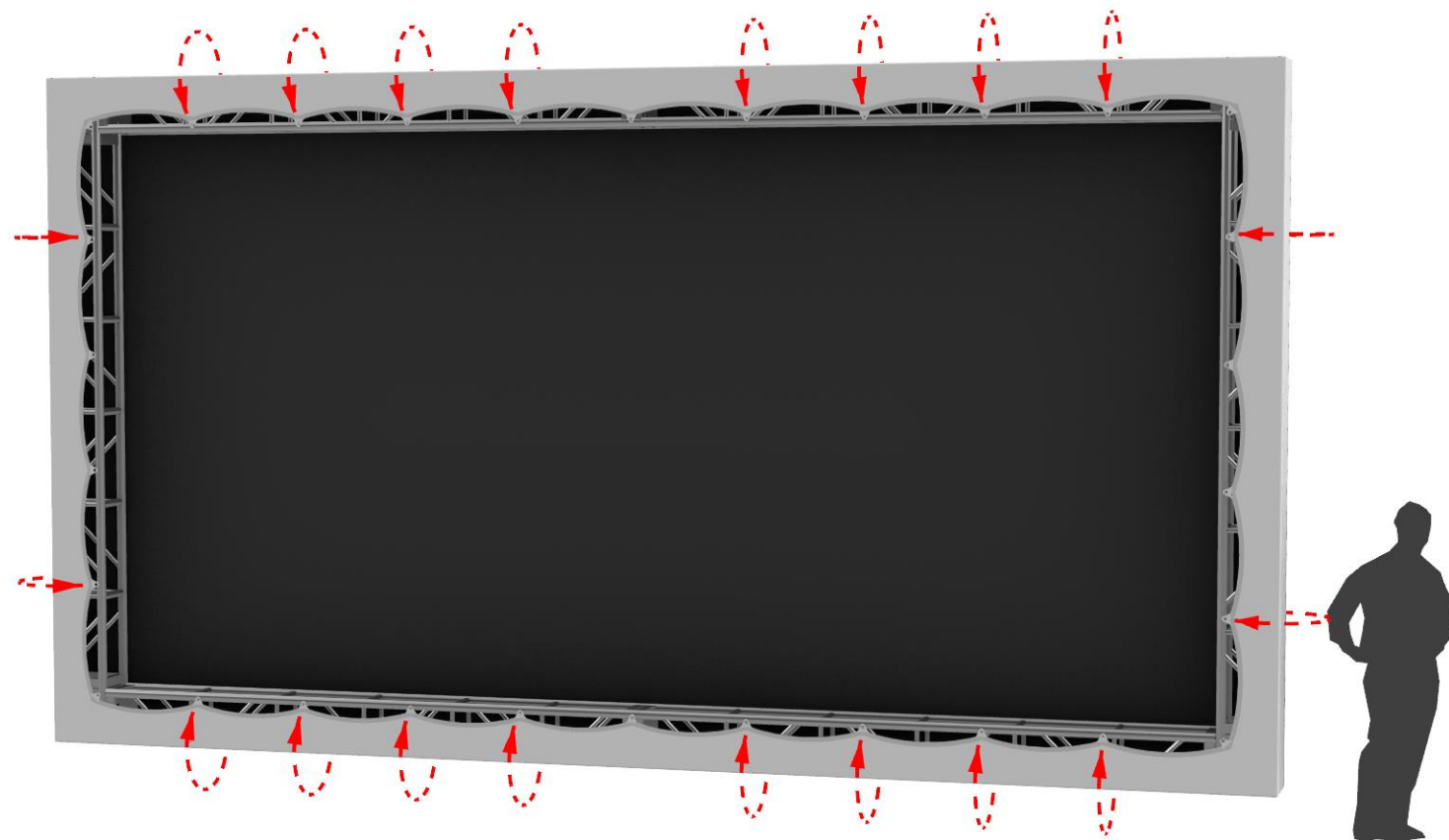
Wrap the fabric cover around the truss structure. Using the provided cable ties, attach the corner rigging points and a few along each edge to hold the cover loosely in place.



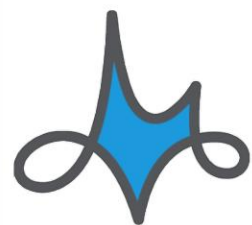
Perspective Detail - Rigging Tab

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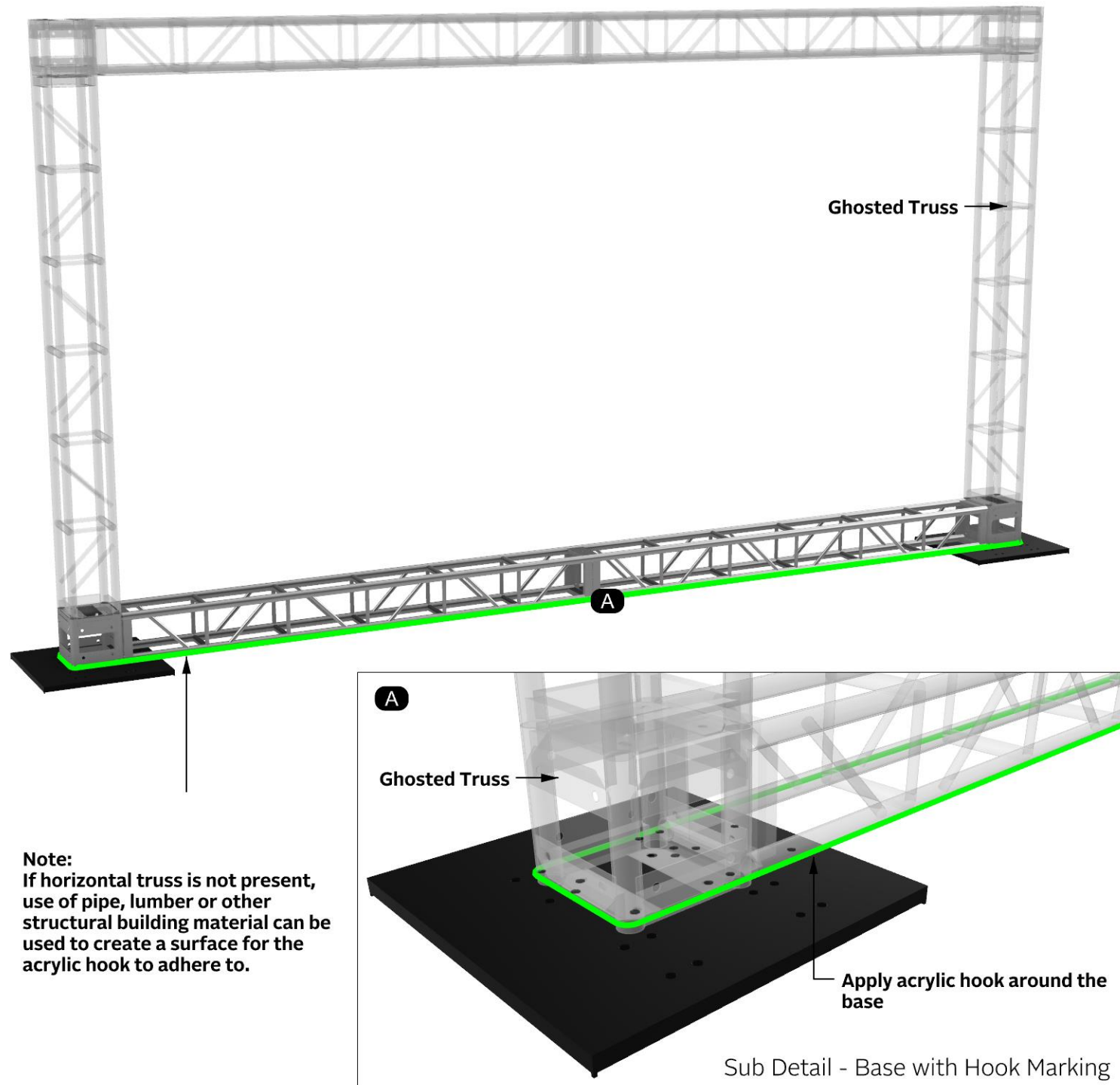

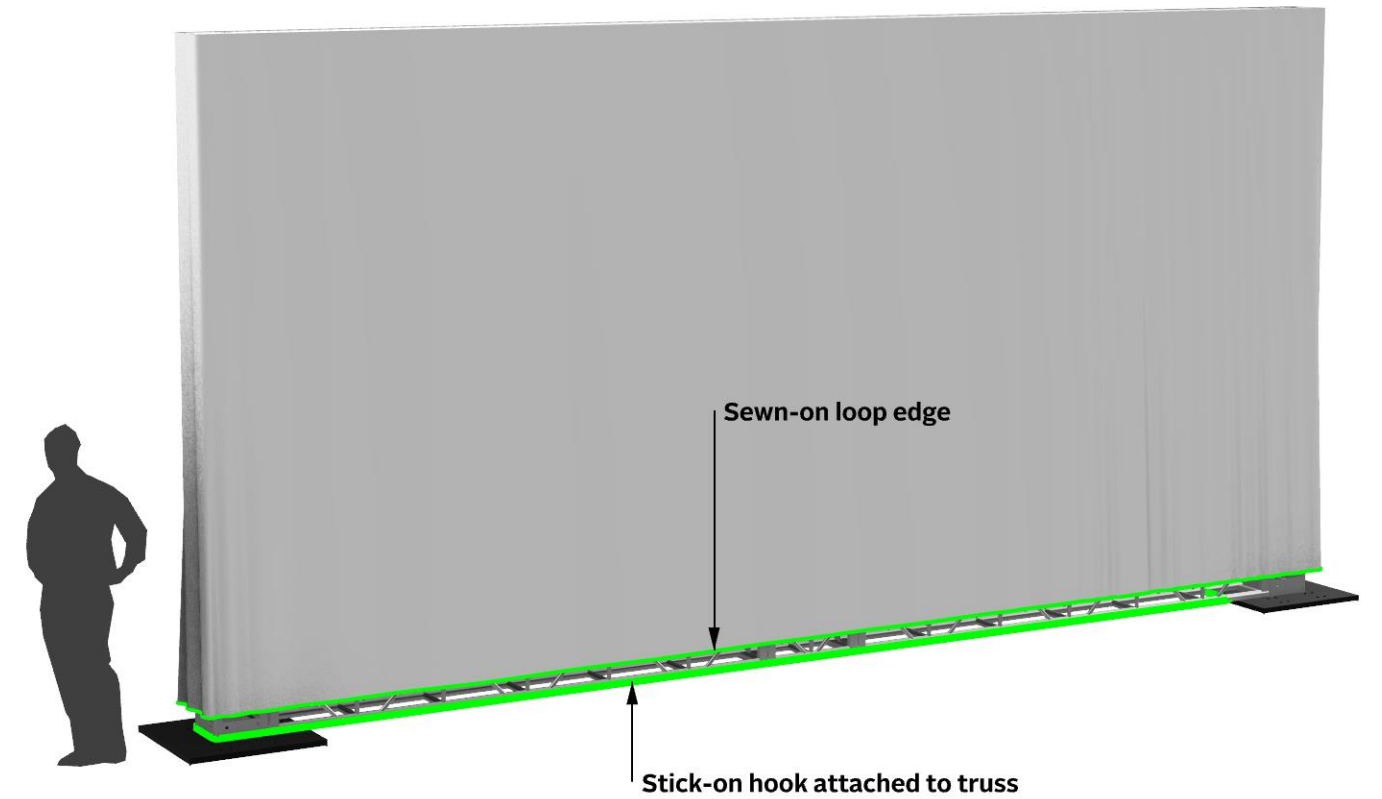
In some cases, your fabric cover may have its structure ground supported, which modifies the finishing design. Apply stick-on acrylic hook around the base of the structure. This will provide a surface for the truss wrap to adhere to on the bottom edge.

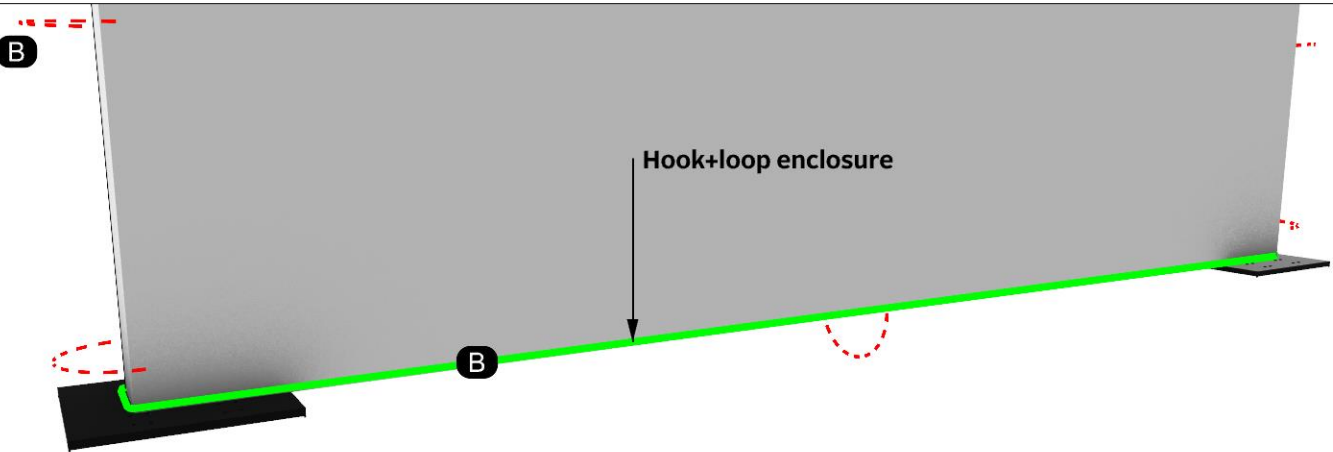
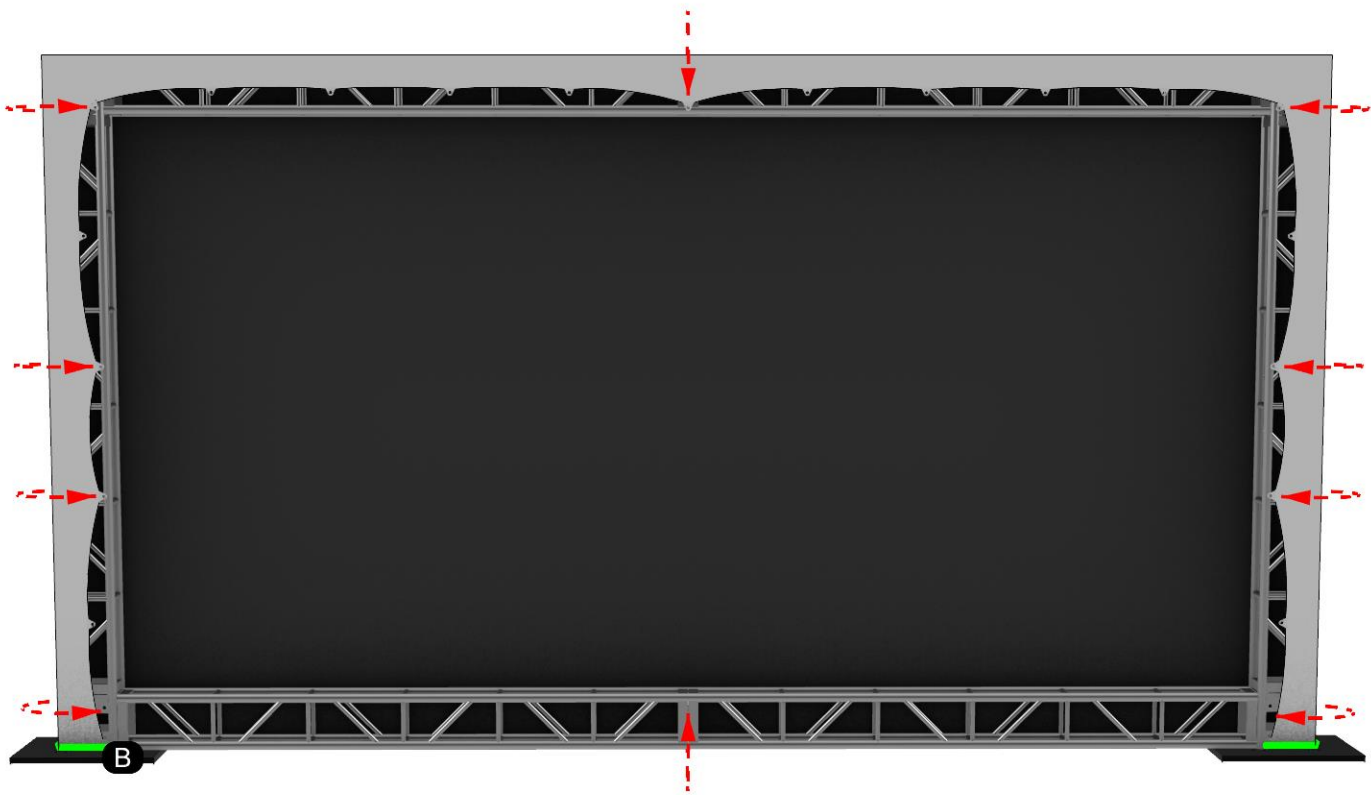
Loosely drape the fabric of your pillowcase truss banner over your constructed truss. Take note that covers that are ground supported may have a sewn-on loop edge around the bottom edge

Wrap the fabric cover around the truss structure. Using the provided cable ties, attach the corner rigging points and a few along each edge to hold the cover loosely in place. Attach the hook+loop enclosure along the bottom edge of the fabric wrap (tagged B).

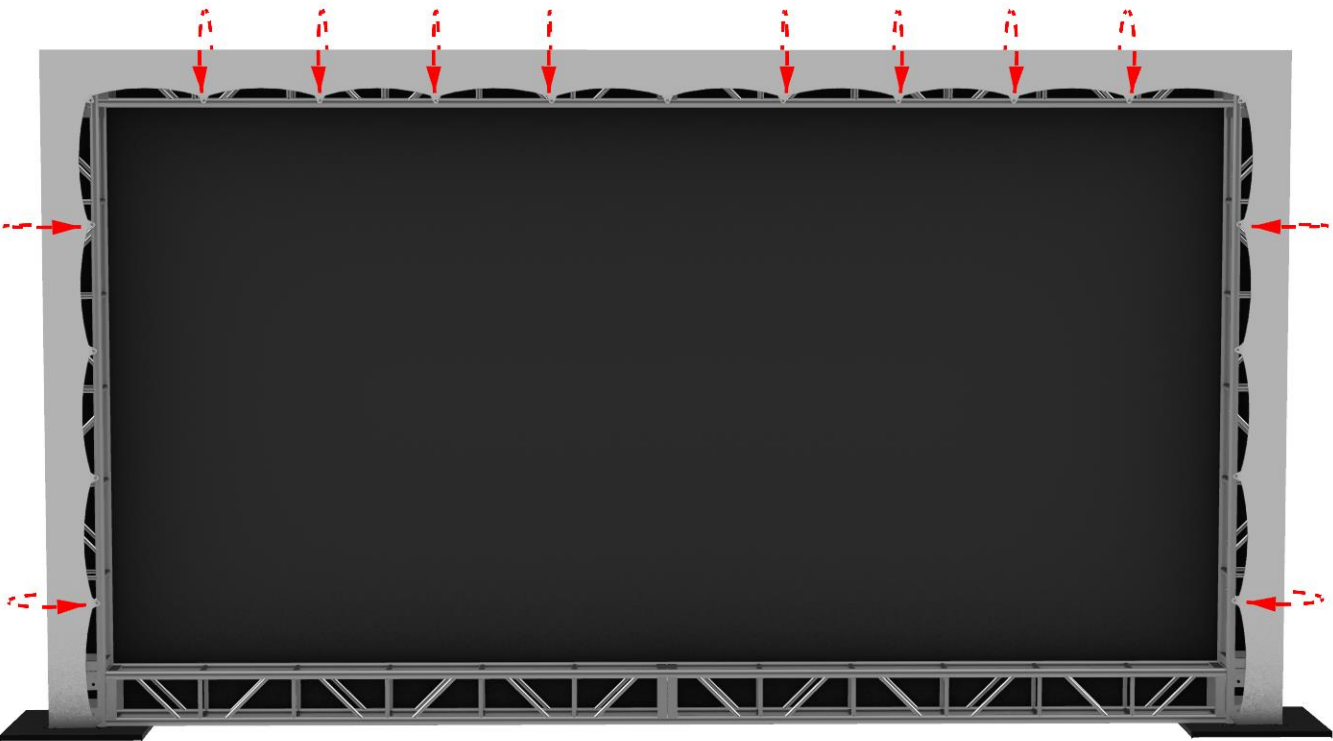


Sub Detail - Base with Hook Marking

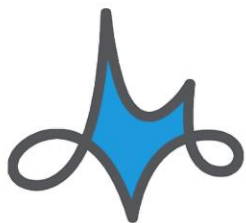
Perspective Detail - Rigging Tab
